- 1. Review of patient history
- 2. Blood pressure screening for adult patients
- 3. X-Rays—absolutely necessary for proper diagnosis and you will be responsible for what insurance will not cover because of multiple visits between us and old DDS. If you have just have them taken, please get copies from DDS and bring with you to your appointment. Please advise us if you are pregnant!
- 4. Charting of existing dental work
- 5. Preliminary examination and prophylaxis (cleaning) by our dental hygienist if you have scheduled for one.
- 6. Comprehensive oral examination including the head and neck by the dentist.
- 7. Treatment plan development and pre-estimate of charges to be incurred if further work is needed.
